

## Tutorial Earrings « Cosmos « © par PUCA®

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## Material:

- 12 Amos® par Puca®
- 12 Piros® par Puca®
- Seed beads 15/0 (R15) 2 Colors, 11/0 (R11)
- 2 synthetic flowers of your choice, 2 firepolished beads 4mm, 2 ball end head pin
- 2 earring findings
- 4 rings 3mm ø
- Fireline 0.12



Pick up alternately 6
 Amos and 6 Piros
 (spike outside and
 Piros upright), repeat
 to tighten




Exit through first Piros and pass through top hole of Piros



3) Pick up 1 R15 between each Piros, exit through next Piros, repeat for the length of the pattern



4) You'll now have this. Exit through R15



5) Pick up 1 R15, exit through bottom hole of Piros



6) Pick up 1 R15, exit through following R15



7) Repeat steps 5 and 6 for the length of the pattern, and exit through R15, Piros, 1st and 2nd hole of Amos



8) Pick up 2 R15 (2nd color) between each Amos, repeat for the length of the pattern



9) You'll now have this. Exit through 1st R15 2nd color



10) Pick up 1 R15, pass through R15, Amos, R15, repeat for the length of the pattern



11) You'll now have this. Exit through central R15



12) Pick up 1 R15 (color2), 1 R11, 1 R15 (color2), exit through central R15. Repeat to strengthen



13) Repeat step 12, on opposite side



14) You'll now have this. Bead the second earring



15) You can now assemble your earring: 1 ball end head pin, 1 firepolished, 1R11, 1 flower, 1 R15. Make a loop with your pin





16) Attach your earring findings and your work with rings

17) Congratulations, you have finished your Cosmos earrings!
