Materials and tools:

PRECIOSA Thorn[™] (**Th**) 111 01 340; 5 x 16 mm; 83120

PRECIOSA Pellet ™ (**P**) 111 01 339; 4 x 7 mm; 83120

PRECIOSA Solo™ (**S**) 117 01 323; 2,5 x 5 mm; 83120

PRECIOSA Rocailles (**R**) 331 39 001; 0/8; 80010

o.20 mm line - the length as needed, it is possible to add an extension; a sewing needle; scissors; pliers for attaching the fastening; the fastening




Procedure:

Step 1:

String 4 **R**, 1 **P**, 1 **R**, 1 **S**, 1 **R** and 1 **P** (fig. no. 1) and tie them into a circle using a double knot (fig. no. 2). Leave ca 8 cm at the end of the line for sewing in. You can sew it in straight away so that the end of the line does not get in the way or you can sew it in at the end of the work as usual.



Step 2: Thread the needle through the first **R** above the **P** (fig. no. 3) and add 3 **R**, 1 **P** and 2 **Th** (fig. no. 4) and thread the needle through the **P** and **R** (fig. no. 5 + fig. no. 6).

Thread the needle through three **R** and one **P** (fig. no. 7 + fig. no. 8), add 1 **R**, 1 **S**, 1 **R**, 1 **P** and 3 **R** (fig. no. 9) and thread the needle through the **R** and **P** (fig. no. 10 + fig. no. 11).



Repeat steps 3 and 4 until the necklace is as long as you need it to be.

Step 6:

Sew the line in and attach the fastening using the pliers. You can thread the line through the necklace one more time in order to ensure that the necklace is strong.

Step 4: You now have to pull the needle through the **R**, **S**, **R**, **P** and **R** (fig. no. 12 + fig. no. 13). Add 3 **R**, 1 **P** and 2 **Th** (fig. no. 14) and thread the needle through the **P** and **R** (fig. no. 15 + fig. no. 16).
