## Sunlight reflected from a surface

This bracelet in the trending colors of Spring/Summer 2023 plays with the colors of the sun and the sea's surface. Choose from the wide range of colors and shapes for PRECIOSA fire polished beads and create an accessory for spring and summer days.

## Materials and tools:

PRECIOSA Fire Polished Beads (FPB)
15119 001; 6 mm (FPBt)
60110/44863 turquoise; 54x
15119 001; 6 mm (FPBb) 20010/44836 blue; 59x

15119 001; 6 mm (FPBo)
80120/44889 orange; 49x

PRECIOSA Imitation Pearls (IP)
13119 001; 6 mm (IPt)
02010/30019 turquoise mother of pearl; 6x
13119 001; 6 mm (IPr)
02010/30004 pink mother of pearl; 6x
13119 001; 6 mm (IPo)
02010/30012 orange mother of pearl; 6x

- a thin needle; a 0.20 mm nylon line; sewing thread; a flexible line (Elastomer, Opelon); scissors



## Difficulty:

Technique: right-angle weave stitch, stringing

## Procedure:

Step 1:
First, sew the guide
Place an $\mathbf{R}$ stop bead at the end of the line. Thread the line through it twice.
String 39x R onto the line. Create six circles one after the other. Go back, thread the line through the $\mathbf{R}$ and add the remaining $\mathbf{R}$. Count off $10 \times \mathbf{R}$ and thread the line through the $10^{\text {th }}$ in the opposite direction.
String $4 \times$ R. Count off $5 \times$ R and thread the line through the $5^{\text {th }}$.
Continue in the same way 3 more times. Tie off the end of the line. Thread the ends through several $\mathbf{R}$ and cut them off.



Step 2:
Sew six guides. 2x using Rg, 2x using Rr and 2x using Ry.


Step 3
Prepare a needle with a large threading loop. Cut off about 15 cm of sewing thread. Thread it through the eye of the needle. Tie off the ends of the threads.
Shift the knot to the side. Thread about 80 cm of flexible line through the thread loop. Fold it in half. You can string the FPB and IP.


Step 4:
You can mix the shades of the FPB and IP as you wish. There are 3 x 9 FPB in the row. There is 1 x IP between each guide.

The layout according to the pattern:
 $R r$ guide, $I P r, R r$ guide, 9x $\operatorname{FPBr}$

Row 2 - Rg guide, IPt, Rg guide, 9x FPBt, Ry guide, IPo, Ry guide, 2x FPBo, 7x FPBr $\mathbf{R r}$ guide, $\mathbf{I P r}, \mathbf{R r}$ guide, 9x $\mathbf{F P B r}$

Row 3 - Rg guide, IPt, Rg guide, 5x FPBt, 1x FPBr, 3x FPBo, Ry guide, IPo, Ry guide, 4x FPBo, 5x FPBr, Rr guide, IPr, Rr guide, 3x FPBr, 6x FPBt

Row 4 - Rg guide, IPt, Rg guide, 4x FPBt, 1x FPBr, 4x FPBo, Ry guide, IPo, Ry guide, 6x FPBo, 3x FPBr, Rr guide, IPr, Rr guide, 5x FPBr, 4x FPBt

Row 5 - Rg guide, IPt, Rg guide, 4x FPBt, 3x FPBr, 2x FPBo, Ry guide, IPo, Ry guide, 9x FPBo, $\operatorname{Rr}$ guide, IPr, $\operatorname{Rr}$ guide, 2x FPBo, 3x FPBr, 4x FPBt

Row 6 - Rg guide, IPt, Rg guide, 3x FPBt, 3x FPBr, 3x FPBo, Ry guide, IPo, Ry guide, 9x FPBo, $\operatorname{Rr}$ guide, IPr, Rr guide, 1x FPBo, 2x FPBr, 6x FPBt
