
**TILA Beads instruction Vol.5 Monotone Necklace** 



Finished size... [Part of necklace] About 63cm (including clasp)

Tools...Scissors · Ruler · Needle nose pliers


1) Make 4pcs of 【A】 using square stitch. Cut four 50cm (1.62ft. )lengths of beading thread, then thread a needle with single thread, leaving a 15cm (5.9in) thread tail.





- 2) Make 2pcs of 【B】 using square stitch. Cut two 150cm (4.86ft.) lengths of beading thread, then thread a needle with single thread, leaving a 15cm(5.9in) thread tail.
- 3) Make 【C】 using square stitch. Cut a 180cm (5.84ft )of beading thread, then thread a needle with single thread, leaving a 15cm(5.9in) thread tail.




4) Make the fringes. Cut a 150cm (4.86ft.) of beading thread, then thread a needle with single thread. String beads as in the picture. If your working thread gets to short, add new thread, and then continue making fringes.




The numbers in the picture represents the number of Delica beads.



## 5) Cut a 2m (6.49ft) of beading thread, then thread a needle with double thread, leaving a 15cm thread tail. Assemble all pieces of $A \cdot B \cdot C$ together while add beads.



When stringing beads, be adjusted the length of bead row to the desired size...



Thread in the picture looks like single thread, but actually it is double thread.
