Material: Bracelet 17 cm

- 36 Amos® par Puca®- Paris
- 8 Minos® par Puca® Paris
- 36 Bicones 3 mm (B3)
- Seed beads 15/0 (SB15),11/0 (SB11), 8/0 (SB8)
- Clasp with chain and stop bead or clasp of your choice
- 2 Cymbals (Pilos)
- Fireline 0.12



1) Alternate on your thread 4 Amos and 4 SB8



2) Close on circle. Exit through SB8 HERE



3) Pick up 3 SB15 through the second hole of the Amos.

All the way around \bigcirc





4) Here is the result 😊 Exit through SB15 after the SB8 HERE



5) Pick up 1 SB15, 1 Cymbal and 1 SB15 through SB15, SB8 and SB15. Reinforce!



6) Exit HERE 😊



7) Pick up 3 SB15, 1 SB11 and 3 SB15 through SB15, SB8 and SB15. Exit HERE.



8) Here is the result \bigcirc Exit through central SB11 HERE



9) Pick up 1 B3 between each central SB11



All the way around \bigcirc

10) Pass another time the thread through SB11 and B3 to arrange the work well. Exit through SB15, SB8 and central SB15 HERE



11) Pick up 1 SB15, 1 Minos and 1 SB15 through SB15, SB8 and SB15. Reinforce!



12) Pick up 1 SB15, 1 SB8 and 1 SB15 through Minos. Reinforce!



13) Turn the work over. Exit through SB8 😊



14) Repeat steps 1 and 2 taking into account that SB8 of step 12 is already placed 😊. Turn the work over



15) Repeat steps 3 e 4. Continue to obtain 9 elements. Think about repeat step 5 on the last element.

End your thread 😊





16) Here is the result 😊

17) Place your clasp © Compliments!
Your bracelet is finished
