

Pendant Tutorial « Azel » © par PUCA®



Made by Puca®



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Material:

- 15 Piros® par Puca®- Paris
- 1 Cabochon® 25 mm par Puca®- Paris
- 20 Bicones 4 mm (B4)
- 21 Firepolished beads 3 mm (F3)
- Seed Beads 15/0 (SB15), 11/0 (SB11)
- 50 cm Chain
- 1 Bail
- 2 Jump rings
- 1 Lobster clasp
- Lacy's Stuff 5 x 5 cm and Leather 5 x 5 cm
- Glue
- Fireline 0.12



1) Glue the cabochon on the Lacy's and make a line around the cabochon which will serve as a reference



2) Poke your needle under Lacy's



3) Place 1 Piros and exit below Lacy's



4) Exit HERE through the Piros



5) Place 1 Piros through Lacy's then go up through the second hole of the Piros. Repeat steps 3 to 5 all around the cabochon



6) Here the result © Exit HERE near the Piros



7) Place 1 SB11, 1 F3 and 1 SB11 and exit under Lacy's



8) Go back to F3 level



9) Pass through the F3 and the SB11. Place 1 F3 and 1 SB11



10) Pass through Lacy's and go up to the F3 level HERE. Repeat steps 7 to 10 the entire row



11) Here the result © Exit through the F3 HERE



12) Place 1 SB15, 1 B4 and 1 SB15



13) Pass through B4, insert 1 SB15 and exit through F3. Place your 20 B4s like this



14) Here the result © Exit through the F3 HERE



15) Place 1 SB11, the bail and 1 SB11 through the next F3 and reinforce. Do not cut the thread



16) Here the result 😊



17) Cut your Lacy's flush with the F3



18) Here the result 😊



19) Place your round of leather previously cut to the same size as Lacy's



20) Insert the needle into both thicknesses (Lacy's and leather)



21) Place 2 SB11, stitch through the two layers (Lacy's and leather) and go up through the 2nd SB11, then place 1 SB11 etc. Make the row like this with 1 SB11 each time



22) Here the result 😊



23) All you have to do is place your chain, rings and lobster clasp. Your pendant is finished



24) Another color 😊
