### Material :

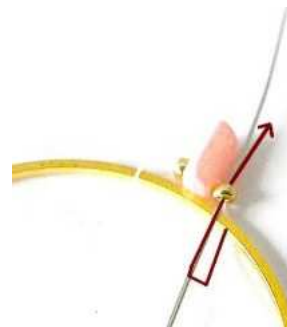
- 14 Piros® par Puca®- Paris color 1 (C1)
- 10 Piros® par Puca®- Paris color 2 (C2)
- 4 Bicones 4 mm (B4)
- 2 Circles 30 mm ø
- 2 Cymbals (Pilos)
- 1 Pair Ear wires
- Seed Beads 15/0 (SB15), 11/0 (SB11) 2 colors
- Fireline 0.12



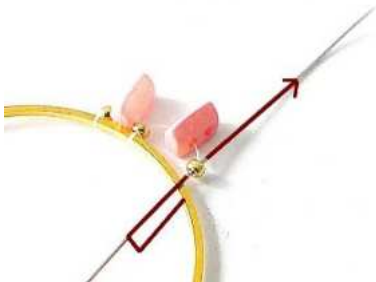
1) Make a knot on the circle



2) Pick up 1 SB15, 1 Piros and 1 SB15



3) Pass under the circle then over the circle and through the SB15 HERE



4) Pick up 1 Piros and 1 SB15. Pass under the circle then over the circle. Exit through SB15 HERE



5) Here is the result 😊 Continue step 4 to place the 14 Piros



6) Here is the result 😊 Exit through SB15 HERE



7) Pick up 1 SB11 (C1) through the Piro (same hole)



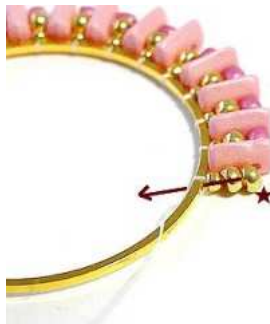
8) Pick up 1 SB11 (C1) between each Piro



9) Here is the result 😊  
Pick up 1 SB11 (C1) through the second hole of the first Piro, then 1 SB11 (C2) between each Piro



10) Here is the result 😊



11) Pick up 1 SB11 through the SB11 and SB15. Exit under the circle



12) Repeat steps 2 to 6. Place 10 Piro inside the circle. Exit through SB15 HERE



13) Pick up 1 SB11 (C1) through the SB11 HERE



14) Exit through the SB15 near the Piro HERE



15) Pick up 1 SB11 (C1) between each Piro (same hole)



16) Here is the result 😊  
Exit HERE through the second hole of Piros



17) Pick up 1 SB15  
between each Piros.  
Exit through the three seed beads HERE



18) Pass under the circle and exit through the three seed beads HERE



19) Pick up 1 B4 and  
1 SB15. Pass through the B4 and exit through the first SB11 HERE



20) Exit HERE through 5<sup>th</sup> Piros. Pass under the circle. Pick up 1 SB15, 1 Cymbal and 1 SB15. Reinforce. Exit through Piros HERE. Repeat step 19 to insert the bicone. End your thread



21) Insert your ear wire



22) Make the second earring 😊
