## Material :



- 16 Arcos $^{\circledR}$ par Puca ${ }^{\circledR}$ - Paris
- 8 Lipsi ${ }^{\circledR}$ par Puca ${ }^{\circledR}$ - Paris
- 24 Piros ${ }^{\circledR}$ par Puca ${ }^{\circledR}$ - Paris
- 27 Bicones 3 mm (B3)
- 19 Bicones 4 mm (B4)
- 12 Flowers 10 mm of your choice
- 22 Delicas 11/0 (DB11)
- Seed Beads 15/0 (SB15), 11/0 (SB11)
- 4 Cymbals (Kolympos) or Jump rings
- 20 cm Chain
- 1 Circle 12 mm, 1 Charm 30 mm, Jump rings 8 mm and 1 Lobster clasp 30 mm
- Fireline 0.12

Pearl 1 : Pearl Anémone


1) Pick up 1 Arcos, 1 SB15 and 1 Arcos

2) Here the result © Exit through the second hole of the Piros

3) Pick up 1 SB15, 3 Piros and 1 SB15 through the Arcos

4) Return your work and exit through the second hole of the Piros

5) Pick up 1 SB15 and 1 Arcos.
Repeat steps 2 and 3 to insert 5 Arcos

6) Pick up 1 SB15, 1 Arcos, 1 SB15, 1 Arcos and 1 SB15 above the Arcos of the previous round. Exit through the 3 Piros HERE. All the way around

7) Here the result $(\bigcirc)$ Exit through the SB15 HERE

8) Return your work.

Exit through the SB15 HERE and repeat step 8

13) Pick up 1 B3, 1 SB15 and 1 B3.
All the way around

16) Pick up 1 B3 and repeat steps 15 and 16 all the way around.
End your thread ())

8) Between each SB15 pick up 1 SB15, 1 B4 and 1 SB15

11) Here the result () Exit HERE through the SB15

14) Here the result © Exit HERE through the second hole of Piros

17) You have finished the Anémone pearl

12) Pick up 1 SB11, 1 Cymbal and 1 SB11. Exit HERE

15) Pick up 1 B3 through the SB15 HERE

## Pearl 2 : Pearl Heart of Mary



1) With 3 Arcos perform the steps 1 to 4 of the Anémone flower

2) Pick up 1 B4, 1 SB15 and 1 B4 and exit HERE

3) End your thread.

You have finished the Heart of Mary pearl

2) Repeat steps 6 and 7 of the Anémone flower () Exit HERE through the SB15

5) Repeat step 4

6) Hit the B4s passing through the SB15s of the Piros second hole
under the circle and exit through the DB11 passing over the circle

7) Pick up the Cymbal. Exit HERE through the DB11 passing under the circle


1) Tie a knot on the circle
2) Pick up 2 DB11
3) Pick up 1 DB11 pass

4) Here the result ©

5) Repeat step 9 all the round. End your thread.
Your Sun pearl is finished

6) Alternate 4 Lipsi and 4 SB11 on your thread

7) Here the result ()) Exit through the SB11 HERE

8) Assemble the two Lipsi on top of each other

9) Pick up 1 SB11, 1 Flower and 1 SB11

10) Close and exit through the SB11

11) Pick up 1 Lipsi between each SB11 (above each Lipsi of the previous round)

12) Repeat step 7 for the 4 Lipsi

13) Pass through the Flower. Pick up 1 SB11 and exit through the Lipsi HERE

14) Pick up 1 SB11 on each SB11

15) Here the result ())

Exit through the second hole of the Lipsi

9) Here the result ().) Exit HERE through the Lipsi

12) Here the result ()

13) Repeat steps 10 and 11 all the round

16) Exit HERE to repeat steps 10 to 16 through the other side of your work

19) Pick up 1 SB11
through the 3 SB11

14) Return your work. Exit through the SB11 HERE

17) Here the result ()

20) Pick up 1 SB11
through the 3 SB11 and exit through the next Lipsi and SB11. Repeat steps 19 and 20 all the round

15) Pick up 1 SB11 between SB11.
All the way around $(3)$

18) Exit HERE through the 3 SB11

21) Here the result ©

Exit through the SB11 HERE

22) Pick up 1 Flower and 1 SB11

23) Pass through the Flower and SB11 HERE

24) Pick up 1 SB15, 1 B4 and 1 SB15 HERE through SB11. Repeat 3 times steps 22 to 24

27) All that remains is to assemble the Elly© bag jewel as you wish

I wish you a happy beading. I offer you this pattern.
