


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Material:


- 10 Arcos[®] par Puca[®]- Paris
- 1 Cabochon 25 mm par Puca®- Paris
- Square cap Léo®par Puca®- Paris
- 10 Bicones 3 mm (B3)
- 10 Bicones 4 mm (B4)
- Seed Beads 15/0 (SB15)
- 10 cm Rhinestone chain 2 mm
- Lacy's Stuff 5 cm x 5 cm
- Glue
- Fireline 0.12



1) Glue your cabochon onto Lacy's Stuff



2) Glue the rhinestone chain around the cabochon and let dry




3) Place the thread passing underneath and exit HERE



4) Insert 1 Samos and 7 **SB15**



Arcos. Go under Lacy's Stuff and go up to 2 mm HERE



6) Repeat steps 4 and 5 all the way around. This is the result \circ Go out of the space under the Arcos HERE



7) Insert 1 B3 and 1 SB15



8) Pass through the B3 and 9) This is the result 😊 exit through the next Arcos Go to exit HERE through passing under Lacy's Stuff. the SB15 above Arcos All the way around 😊





10) Insert 1 B4 between each group of SB15. All the way around 😊



11) This is the result 😊



12) Cut Lacy's Stuff under the Arcos



13) Glue the work on the cap HERE.
