



Tutorial Bracelet « Farandole » © par PUCA®



Made by Puca



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Material :

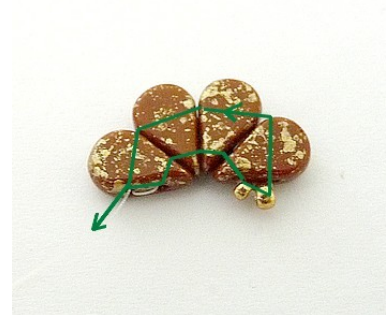
- 48 Amos® par Puca®
- 12 Round beads 4 mm (PR4)
- Seed beads 15/0 (R15), 11/0 (R11)
- 15 cm partially finished bracelet
- 2 thin rings 3mm
- Fireline 0.12



1) Pick up 1 Amos, 1 R15, 1 R11 and exit through Amos, repeat to strengthen



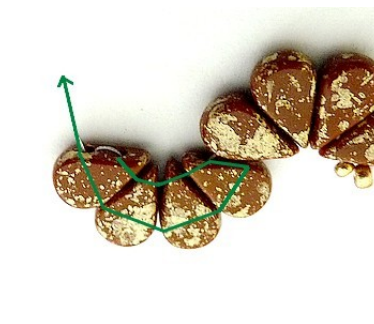
2) Pick up 3 Amos, top hole



3) Pass through all bottom hole of Amos, seed beads and top hole of Amos



4) Pick up 4 Amos, top hole (but you must place the Amos like picture)



5) Pass through bottom hole and then top hole of Amos, exit like picture



6) Repeat steps 4 and 5 until you have used a total of 48 Amos 😊. Pick up 1 R11 and 1 R15 after the last Amos. Repeat to strengthen



7) Pick up 1 R15, 1 PR4, 1 R15, exit through the 4 top hole of 4 Amos



8) Repeat step 7 for the length of the pattern



9) Exit through the seed beads and repeat step 7 for the length of the pattern



10) You will now have this 😊



11) Exit like picture



12) Pick up 5 R15 between the 2 round beads. Repeat for the length of the pattern 😊



13) Place your chain with 2 rings and add partially finished bracelet



14) Congratulations! You have finished your bracelet 😊
