

Pendant Tutorial « Flowers Duo » © par PUCA®



Made by Puca®



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Material:

- 12 News Athos ® par Puca®- Paris (2 colors)
- 2 Cabochons 8 mm (2 colors)
- 12 Bicones 3 mm (B3) (2 colors)
- 12 Bicones 4 mm (B4) (2 colors)
- Seed Beads 15/0 (SB15), 11/0 (SB11)
- 60 cm Chain, 2 Jump rings 4 mm,
 2 Rings 7 mm, 1 Lobster Clasp
- 1 Cymbal Kolympos
- Glue
- Fireline 0.12



1) Alternate6 New Athos and 6 SB11on your thread



2) Close and exit through the SB11 HERE



3) Insert 4 SB15 through the second hole of New Athos



4) Insert 4 SB15 through central SB11



5) Exit through the first SB15 HERE. Insert 3 SB15 through New Athos. Repeat steps 3 to 5 all the round



6) Here is the result ©
Exit through the first SB15
HERE



7) Insert 1 B3 through SB15 and exit through the New Athos.
All the way around



8) Here is the result © Exit through SB15 HERE



9) Insert 5 SB15 through the third hole of New Athos



10) Insert 5 SB15 and exit HERE through SB15. Repeat steps 9 and 10 for the entire round



11) Here's the result © Exit through the 2 SB15 HERE



12) Insert 1 SB15, 1 B4 and 1 SB15 into the 2 SB15 HERE



13) Here is the result © Exit HERE from 2 SB15.

Don't stop the thread ©



14) Make the second flower identical to the first



15) Glue the flowers on top of each other at the New Athos level



16) Take up the thread and insert 7 SB15, 1 SB11 and 7 SB15. Exit HERE. Continue like this for the entire round



17) Except for the last New Athos!



18) Insert 5 SB15, 1 SB11, 1 Cymbal, 1 SB11 and 5 SB15



19) Turn the work over.
Insert 5 SB15 through
SB11 of the first flower.
This allows you to
assemble the two sides.
Insert 5 SB15 on the other
side. All the way around



20) For the Cymbal: Insert 5 SB15 through the SB11, the cymbal and the SB15. Finally end the thread



21) Glue the cabochon 8 mm in the center



22) Do the same on the other side



23) Place the 7 mm rings to insert the chain, lobster clasp etc.

I wish you a happy beading. I offer you this pattern.
