## Material: Bracelet 17 cm (10 Elements)

- 22 Arcos<sup>®</sup> par Puca<sup>®</sup>- Paris
- 22 Kalos <sup>®</sup>par Puca <sup>®</sup>- Paris
- 66 Piros® par Puca®- Paris
- Seed Beads 15/0 (SB15)
- 2 Cymbals or Jump rings 4 mm ø
- 1 Clasp of your choice ©
- Fireline 0.12

## For the bracelet:



1) Pick up 1 Arcos, 1 SB15, 1 Cymbal and 1 SB15 through the bottom hole of Arcos




2) Pick up 2 Piros and 1 Arcos



3) Pick up 1 SB15, 1 Kalos and 1 SB15 through the Arcos



4) Pick up 2 Piros through the next Arcos



5) Exit HERE and pick up1 Piros between the2 Piros down.Exit HERE through thePiros



6) Pick up 1 Piros between the Piros up. Exit HERE through the Arcos



7) Pick up 1 SB15 between each Piros (second hole). Exit HERE through the Arcos



8) Pick up 1 SB15 between each Piros like step 7. Exit HERE through the hole of Kalos



9) Pick up 1 SB15, 1 Arcos, 2 Piros and 1 Arcos like step 2. Repeat steps 3 to 8 to make the second element



10) Here is the result © Exit HERE through the second hole of Kalos




11) Make 10 elements for a 17 cm bracelet .
End the thread



12) Pick up your clasp 
The clasp with stopping bead and little chain is ideal

## For the ring:



13) Make one element and continue to insert the Kalos according to the size of your finger



14) You get a very cute ring ©
