Material :

- 33 Lipsi® par Puca®- Paris
- 22 Kalos® par Puca®- Paris
- 11 Samos® par Puca®- Paris
- 1 Support Juliette® par Puca®- Paris
- 11 Round Beads 3 mm (RB3)
- 11 Bicones 3 mm (B3)
- 1 Wooden Bead 20 mm
- Seed Beads 15/0 (SB15), 11/0 (SB11)
- 2 Jump rings 4 mm ø
- 2 Caps 6 mm
- 1 Headpin 7 cm
- 1 Key Chain of your choice
- 1 Charm o Knot Bead
- 10 cm Chain of your choice
- Paint
- Glue
- Fireline 0.12



1) Alternate on the thread 11 Lipsi and 11 SB15.
Close to circle.
Exit through the second hole of the Lipsi



2) Place the work on the Juliette® support



3) Pick up 1 SB11 between each Lipsi and exit through the SB11 HERE



4) Insert 2 SB15, 1 SB11,
2 SB15 between each
SB11.
All the way around 😊



5) Here is the result 😊
Exit through the central
SB11



6) Pick up 1 SB15, 1 Kalos,
1 SB15 between each
central SB11



7) Here is the result 😊
Exit through the second
hole of the Kalos



8) Pick up 1 Lipsi between
each Kalos.
All the way around 😊



9) Here is the result 😊
Exit through the Lipsi
HERE



10) Pick up 2 SB15
between each Lipsi.
All the way around 😊
Exit through the second
hole of Lipsi HERE



11) Remove the work
from the support and put
some HERE glue (red
stars).
Brush glue onto edge of
support



12) Here is the result 😊
Pick up 1 B3 between
each Lipsi.
All the way around 😊



13) Here is the result 😊
Exit through the Lipsi
HERE



14) Pick up 2 SB15, 1 SB11
and 2 SB15 between each
Lipsi



15) Here is the result 😊
Exit through the central
SB11



16) Pick up 1 Samos,
1 SB15, 1 SB11 and 1
SB15 through the second
hole of the Samos.
Exit through the central
SB11.
All the way around 😊



17) Here is the result 😊
Exit through the three
rocailles HERE



18) Turn over your work.
Pick up 1 Kalos between
the three rocailles.
All the way around 😊



19) Here is the result 😊
Exit through the second
hole of the Kalos HERE



20) Pick up 1 Lipsi
between each Kalos.
All the way around 😊



21) Here is the result 😊
Exit through the Lipsi
HERE



22) Pick up 2 SB15 through the next Lipsi. All the way around 😊



23) Here is the result 😊 Exit through the second hole of the Lipsi



24) Pick up 2 SB15 between each Lipsi. All the way around 😊 Exit through the 2 SB15 HERE



25) Pick up 2 SB15, 1 SB11 and 2 SB15 through the 2 SB15. All the way around 😊



26) Here is the result 😊 Exit through the central SB11



27) Pick up 1 RB3 between each central SB11



28) Here is the result 😊 Reinforce and end your thread



29) Making the assembly 😊 Place the headpin and the cap inside the support. An idea : put a tassel in the support 😊



30) On the other side, insert the wooden pearl already painted then the cap



31) Make a ring 😊



32) Place the charm or the knot bead



33) Place the key chain with jump rings and a piece of chain
