

## Spiral Tutorial «Lovely » © par PUCA®®



Made by Puca®


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- 110 Lipsi ${ }^{\circledR}$ par Puca ${ }^{\circledR}$ - Paris
- Seed Beads 15/0 (SB15), 11/0 (SB11)
- 1 Flower 10 mm of your choice
- 2 Cymbals
- 3 Jump rings 4 mm $\varnothing$
- 1 Clasp of your choice
- Fireline 0.12

4) Here is the result $\because$ Exit HERE
5) Alternate 4 Lipsi and 4 SB11 on your thread
6) Close and exit HERE through the second hole of the Lipsi

7) Tighten the work well and exit HERE through the SB11


8) Pick up 1 SB11 between each Lipsi
9) Pick up 2 SB15, 1 SB11 and 2 SB15 between each SB11

10) Here is the result $\because$ Exit through the central SB11

11) Pick up 1 SB15, 1 Cymbal and 1 SB15 in the SB11 in front and reinforce

12) Here is the result $\because$ Exit through the central SB11
13) Pick up 1 SB11 between each SB11

14) Here is the result Exit HERE through the SB11 under

15) Pick up 1 Lipsi between each central SB11
16) Here is the result $\ominus^{3}$ Exit through the SB11 of step 7

17) Pick up 1 SB15, 1 SB11 and 1 SB15 through the same bead.
All the way around

18) Here is the result Exit through the second hole of the Lipsi

19) Pick up 1 SB11 between each Lipsi and repeat steps 12 to 16. Place 26 rounds of Lipsi for a 17 cm bracelet

For the Flower charm :

19) Alternate 4 Lipsi and 4 SB11 on your thread and close. Exit through the Lipsi HERE

22) Pick up the flower and 1 SB11
17) For the extremity repeat steps 6 to 10

20) Pick up 2 SB15 on each side of the Lipsi

23) Pass through the flower then the Lipsi HERE like picture

18) End your thread $\because$

21) Here is the result $\because$ Exit through the Lipsi HERE

24) Exit HERE through the two SB15

25) Pick up 2 SB15, 1 SB11 and 2 SB15 on each Lipsi

26) Here is the result $\because$ End your thread

27) It is possible to make this spiral with 5 Lipsi as well as the flower charm ©
It is possible to make a necklace ${ }^{3}$

I wish you a happy beading. I offer you this pattern.
