Photo tutorial



Material :

- 48 Daggers Collection Transparent Constellation FP Selection®
- 1 Heart Collection Transparent Constellation FP Selection®
- 2 Cabochons® par Puca® 18 mm
- 18 Round Beads 3 mm (RB3)
- Seed beads Miyuki 11/0 (SB11) two colors C1 and C2
- Clasp of your choice
- 2 Jump Rings and Chain of your choice
- Fireline 0.15
- Nylon thread 0.15
- Fine and flexible Needle

1) Insert on your thread 4 SB11 and close.



2) Add 1 SB11 between each seed bead.



Here is the result.

3) Insert 2 SB11 between each protruding seed bead.



Here is the result.

4) Insert 1 SB11 between each seed bead.



Here is the result.

5) Insert 2 SB11 color 2 (C2) between each seed bead color 1 (C1).



Here is the result.



6) Insert 1 SB11 C1 on each seed bead C1, placed previously.

Here is the result.

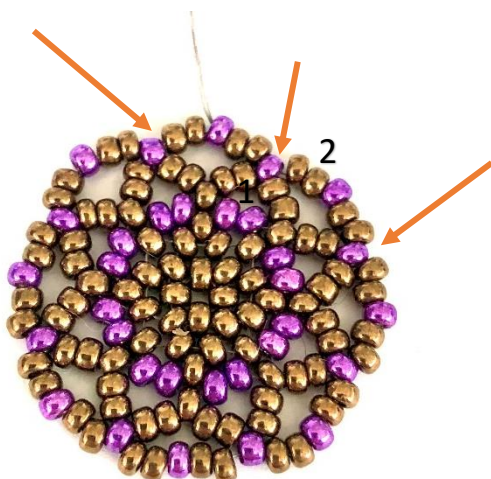


7) Between each protruding seed bead, insert :

2 SB11 (C1),
1 SB11 (C2),
2 SB11 (C1).

Here is the result. It's round 1.

These steps will be repeated a total of 5 times. The spaces thus created will be used to place the Daggers.



8) Repeat the previous round, this time positioning yourself on the protruding seed beads C2 (arrows).

Here is the result. It's round 2.



9) Repeat the previous step.

Start rounding the work keeping it very tight.

Here is the result. It's round 3.



10) Place the two cabochons on top of each other and continue working, taking into account the roundness.

Exit HERE (arrow) and begin the round as in the previous step.

Continue like this to form round 4.



11) Here is the result.

Exit HERE through SB11 C2 (arrow) to start the next round.

Place round 5 by carefully folding the arches along the contours of the cabochon.

12) Insert 2 SB11 C1 between each seed bead C2.

Reinforce the work by passing through the seed beads again.

Here is the result.



13) Exit HERE (arrow).

Insert 1 SB11 C1 through the next 2 SB11 C1.

All the way around.



14) Here is the result.

Tighten well.



15) Insert 1 SB11 C2 between each seed bead previously positioned.



16) Here is the result.



17) Insert 1 SB11 C1 between each seed bead previously positioned.

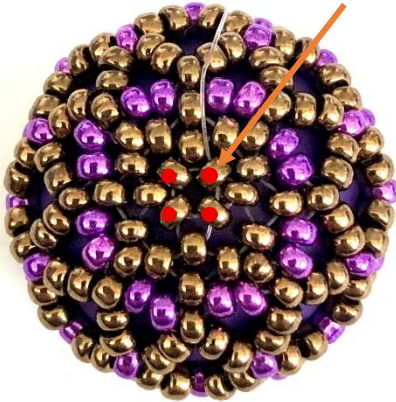
Here is the result.



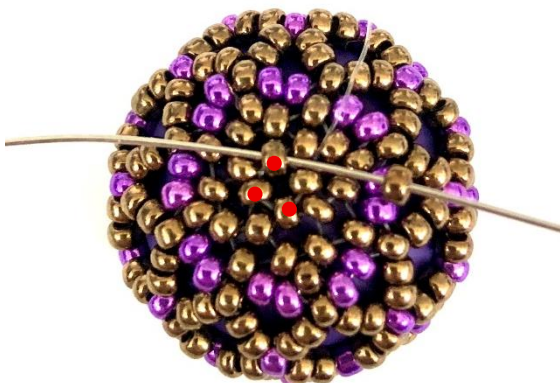


18) Fill in the gaps by inserting C1 seed beads.

The pendant base is complete.



19) Exit HERE (arrow) in one of the first four seed beads C1 of step 1.



20) Insert 1 SB11 C1 through the second seed bead of step 1.

Continue in this way for the last two seed beads C1 of step 1.

21) Here is the result.



22) As in step 2, place an SB11 C1 between each seed bead.



Here is the result.

Reinforce again.



23) The square is formed.

Identify a diagonal and exit the thread HERE (arrow).

Insert 3 SB11s C1 and enter the opposite SB11 that forms the diagonal.

Strengthen well by passing the thread through the three beads several times, alternating the entry and exit points.

24) Here is the result.



Let the thread slide and finish between the seed beads.

25) Insert a jump ring between the arch formed in the previous step.



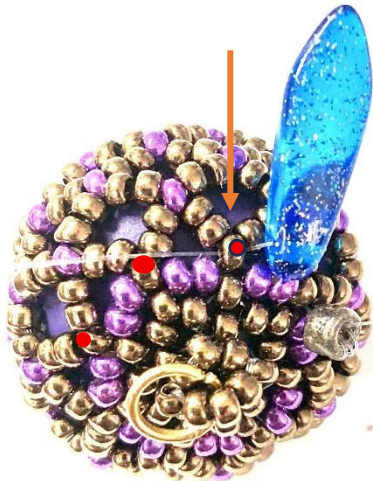
26) Place a stopper bead on a new thread and position it HERE (arrow).



We will place the daggers, alternating the six colors of the collection.

Note :

The thread used is 0.15 mm nylon.



27) Place a Dagger through SB11 C1
HERE (arrow).

Repeat this process along the entire
row.



28) Here is the result.

Exit HERE (arrow) through the SB11
C2 to start the next round.

Leave the excess yarn on hold.



29) Place 2 Daggers in each empty
space in row 2.

Here is the result.

Exit HERE (arrow) through the SB11 C2 to start the next row, which will be row 3.



30) Repeat step 29 for the round 3 with the Daggers.



Here is the result.

31) For the last row of Daggers, which is row 4, place a single Dagger as in step 27.



Here is the result.

Exit HERE (arrow) through the SB11 C2.



32) Place on your thread 1 SB11 C1, 1 RB3, 1 SB11 C1, enter through the next SB11 C2 HERE (arrow).

All the way around.

Tighten well.



33) Exit HERE (arrow) through the next SB11 C2 and start another row like previously step.

34) Like that.



35) Here is the result.

One of the two SB11s C1 naturally positions itself flat like this.



36) Come and position yourself at the center of the work and follow steps 20 to 22.



37) Here is the result.

Position yourself in the center of the square.

Insert 1 RB3, 1 Heart, 1 RB3.

Pass the needle through the Heart and back into RB3.

Return to the center and pull the thread through the work.



38) Here is the result.



End your thread and any remaining thread hanging from the first row of Daggers, tightening well.

Place chain, jump rings and clasp of your choice.

"Maeva" Pendant is finished.



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
