



## Diagram Pearl « Maloya » © par PUCA®

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Designed by Puca®



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Materials: For 1 bead

- 5 Samos® par Puca®- Paris
- 5 Piros® par Puca®-Paris
- 5 Fire Polished beads 3mm (F3)
- Seed Beads 15/0 (R15), 11/0 (R11) colour
- Fireline 0.12



1) Place 5 Samos, 5 R11 alternately.



2) Close and place yourself HERE in the R11.



3) Place 1 R15, 1 R11 and 1 R15 between each R11.



4) We get this 😊 Place yourself in the central R11 HERE.



5) Place 1 coloured R11 between each R11. Tighten 😊



6) We get this 😊 . Place yourself HERE in the Samos.



7) Place 1 Piro between each Samos.



8) We get this 😊.



9) Turn your work over and place yourself HERE in the second hole of the Piro.



10) Between each Piro, place 1 R15, 1 F3 and 1 R15.



11) We get this 😊. Close your thread



12) Your « Maloya » pearl is now finished. The Pearl Maloya© has multiple uses.

Example: a necklace ➡



13) Place your Maloya© pearl on a cable thread and secure it with 2 crimp beads by passing them through the F3.



Place your Maloya© pearl on your cable wire to make a pretty spring necklace 😊 in several colours 😊. With 11 beads (provide the materials).



15) For a pair of earrings, I added 4 R15s in the F3 at the level of a Samos, to place a leverback earring clasp, then 6 R15s at the bottom to place a stem with 1 heart. Next photo ➡



16) The heart is mounted on a rod, with 1 Caps and 1 R11. I make a loop and place it in the 6 R15 from step 15.

17) Have fun with colours 😊 Bracelets, charms, bag jewellery, etc. will be the perfect touch to your spring jewellery 😊
