

MINI STACKERS BRACELET




Mini GemDuos are the perfect size for stacking on your wrist.

MATERIALS

1.5g size 11° seed beads
18 mini GemDuos in 3 colors
6 PILOS Cymbal™ endings
2 size 6mm jump rings
1 partially finished bracelet finding
2 charms or dangles (optional)
6lb. Fireline
2 size 11 beading needles
Scissors/pliers

SKILL LEVEL: Confident beginner and up **TECHNIQUES:** Stitching with two-hole beads, stitching with two needles



TIPS:

- When using a partially finished bracelet finding, your beadwork needs to span wrist bone to wrist bone.
- Check that all holes of any two-hole beads are clear before stitching.
- Be careful not to skip any beads when retracing a thread path.
- Second thread paths are not shown in the illustrations.

SECTIONS (make a total of 3)

FIGURE 1

Step 1. Thread a needle on each end of 24" of thread. String one 11°, one PILOS ending and one 11°. Move to the center of the thread.

FIGURE 2

Step 2. On one needle, string one mini GemDuo and one 11° eighteen times (**black thread**). With second needle, sew through the open hole of the first mini. String one 11° and sew through the next mini seventeen times. String one additional 11° (**red thread**). **NOTE:** Make sure the beadwork is centered on the thread before continuing.

FIGURE 3

Step 3 (black thread). String a PILOS on one needle, sew through all the beads again and exit the PILOS added in Step 1.

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Step 4 (red thread). With the second needle, sew through the PILOS just added. Continue through all the beads and exit the PILOS added in Step 1.


Step 5. With one needle, continue through several beads, secure the thread with several half-hitch knots along the way, and trim excess. Repeat this step with the second needle.

BRACELET ASSEMBLY

Step 6. Use pliers to open one jump ring and attach the sections through the PILOS loops to one leg of the partially finished bracelet end. Repeat this step to attach the second leg of bracelet end.



Opaque coral red – mini GemDuos Opaque black – mini GemDuos Opaque white luster – mini GemDuos Duracoat galvanized silver – 11° seed beads Antique silver – PILOS endings
