Painting the supports : Juliette[®] and wooden pearl 20 mm


Material:

- 6 Athos[®] par Puca[®]- Paris •
- 1 Support Juliette© par Puca[®]- Paris
- 1 Wooden bead 20 mm
- 1 Acrylic flower (15 or 20 mm wide, 12 mm high for the feet (\bigcirc)
- 1 Fabric flower 20 mm (optional)
- 6 Bicones 4 mm (B4)
- Seed Beads 15/0 (SB15) 2 colors (C2), 11/0 (SB11) and 8/0 (SB8)
- 50 cm Chain, 1 Bail, 2 Jump rings and 1 Lobster Clasp
- 1 Headpin 7 cm and 1 Cap 8 mm
- Glue and painting
- Fireline 0.12



1) Alternate on the thread 2) Insert 3 SB15 into the 6 Athos and 6 SB8. Close. Exit through the SB8







3) Insert 3 SB15 into SB8



4) Exit through the first SB15 and enter 2 SB15 in the second hole of Athos HERE



5) Repeat steps 3 and 4 for the entire round. Here is the result \odot Exit the first SB15 HERE



6) Insert 1 SB15 between the SB15 (C2). Throughout the entire round



7) Here is the result 😊 Exit throught the 3 SB15 HERE



8) Insert 4 SB15 in the last hole of Athos



9) Insert 4 SB15 into 3 SB15 HERE. Repeat steps 8 and 9 for the entire round



10) Here is the result 😊 Exit the latest SB15 HERE



11) Insert 1 B4 between each SB15. All the way around ⓒ



12) Here is the result 😊 End your thread



13) Glue the acrylic flower onto the support, narrowest part of the support ^(C)



14) Another flower 😇 You have choices 😇



15) Glue the work onto the Juliette support, widest part of the support



16) Insert your headpin with 1 SB11 through the Juliette support



17) Insert the wooden bead (head) and 1 Cap



18) Insert the flower on the headpin. Form a ring on the headpin to insert the bail



19) Place your chain, rings and lobster clasp



20) Another color 😊
