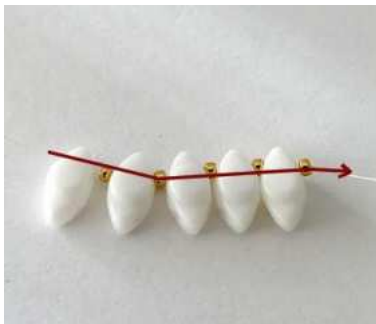

### Material :

- 30 Volos® par Puca®- Paris Color 1 (C1)
- 10 Volos® par Puca®- Paris Color 2 (C2)
- 5 Arcos® par Puca®- Paris Color 1 (C1)
- 5 Arcos® par Puca®- Paris Color 2 (C2)
- 1 Metallic Circle 60 mm, thickness 0,8
- Seed beads 15/0 (SB15), 11/0 (SB11)
- Cordon
- Fireline 0.12

Volos® are positioned in two ways: **front** (relief) and **back** (flat)



1) Alternate on your thread 5 Volos (C1 front) and 5 SB11



2) Close and exit HERE from the upper hole of the Volos.  
Flip to the back



3) Insert 1 Arcos (C1), 1 SB15, 2 Volos (C1 front), 1 SB15 and exit through the Arcos and the next Volos.  
All the way around 😊



4) Here is the result 😊  
Exit through SB15 HERE



5) Insert 1 Volos (C2 back), 1 SB15 and 1 Volos (C2 back). Exit HERE.  
All the way around 😊



6) Here is the result 😊  
Exit HERE through the Volos (C2 back)



7) Insert 2 Volos (C1 front) between Volos (C2)



8) Insert 1 SB15 through the next Volos (C2)



9) Insert 1 Volos (C1 front) through the next Volos and 1 SB15 through the Volos (C2). Repeat steps 7 to 9 all the round 😊



10) Here is the result 😊 Exit HERE through the Volos (C1)



11) Insert 1 Arcos (C2) and the circle. Pass below the circle



12) Pass above the circle and exit HERE through the central hole of Volos (C1)



13) Insert 1 SB11 and exit HERE through the Arcos and below the circle



14) Pass above the circle and exit HERE. Repeat steps 11 to 14 all the round. End your thread 😊



15) You have finished « Mon Étoile » 😊



16) Thread a cord to attach it to the tree 😊

17) I wish you a Happy Christmas 2024 😊
