## Material :

- 14 Samos<sup>®</sup> par Puca<sup>®</sup>
- 84 Piros<sup>®</sup>par Puca<sup>®</sup>
- 14 Bicones 3 mm (B3)
- 1 Wooden stand Napkin Ring par Puca<sup>®</sup>
- Seed beads 15/0 (SB15), 11/0 (SB11) Réf : 194
- 56 Czech Faceted Round Beads 3 mm (F3) Crystal
- Paint and Glue
- Fireline 0.12



1) Paint your support



2) Pick up 1 Samos, 2 Piros, 1 Samos, 2 Piros



3) Close and exit HERE through the Piros



4) Pick up 1 SB11 between the Piros and exit HERE through the Piros



5) Pick up 1 SB11 and exit HERE through the Samos



6) Pick up 1 SB15, 1 B3, 1 SB15 and enter through the same Samos



7) Come and exit HERE through the Piros



8) Pick up 1 SB15 through the B3



9) Pick up 1 SB15 through the Samos and exit HERE through the Samos



10) Pick up 1 SB11 through the second hole of Piros, 1 SB11 through the central SB11



11) Pick up 1 SB11 through the Piros



12) Pick up 1 SB11 through the Samos. Repeat steps 10 to 12 on the other side



13) You'll have this Come and exit HERE to the second hole of the Samos



14) Repeat steps 2 to 13



15) You'll have this 😇 We do this for the 14 Samos







17) Place your beading on the support by sticking at the level of the Samos.Place your beading correctly (same distance on each side)



18) Place your wire HERE in the Piros (top hole)



19) Place 1 Piros through the Piros and the SB11



20) Place 1 SB11 between the SB11 and exit through the Piros. Repeat steps 19 and 20 the entire row



21) Exit through the top hole of the Piros



22) Place 1 F3 through the SB11 and 1 F3 through the Piros. Repeat across the row



23) Place 1 SB11 between the F3. Repeat across the row



24) Repeat steps 18 to 23 to do the other side Congratulations ! You have finished your Napkin Ring « Festif » ©
