These are colorful and happy earrings thanks to the seed beads from the PRECIOSA PermaLux collection supplemented with gold, the traditional color of Christmas. Make them for yourself or give somebody the Christmas earrings just to make them happy or as a gift under the tree. We wish you a merry and colorful Christmastime.

Materials and tools:

- PRECIOSA Rocailles 331 19 001; 10/0; 22m18 teal green; 55x
- 331 19 001; 10/0; a mix of colors; 11x
- 331 19 001; 8/0; 22008 wildbery red; 2x
- PRECIOSA Cut Rocailles 361 11 001; 10/0; 68304 gold; 4x
- a fine 0.1 mm line; a needle; connecting rings; earring hooks; scissors; pliers




Difficulty:


Technique: brick stitch

Procedure:

Step 1


Sew according to the pattern (fig, no. 1a). Sew the first row the Christmas tree according to the pattern (fig. no. 1b). Always start with the widest row in the pattern. Start with row no. 2 in the Christmas tree (fig. no. 1a).





Step 2 Cut off ca 1.5 m of line. Then string 2x rocailles, pull them to the end of the line and tie a double knot (fig. no. 2a). Sew a line (fig. no. 1a) of eleven green rocailles (fig. nos. 2b-2e).




















Step 3

String 1x rocaille in the second row, pass the needle under the line between the last two rocailles (fig. no. 3a). Then pass the needle up through the newly added rocaille one more time (fig. nos. 3b-3c). Add the rocailles to the end of the row in the same way (fig. nos. 3d-3g); follow the pattern (fig. no. 1a).




















Step 4 Sew the triangle according to the pattern (fig. no. 1a) in the same way (fig. nos. 4a-4ch). String 1x 8/0 rocaille at the end (fig. no. 4ch).













Step 5 Work your way down to the bottom row and sew on the tree trunk (fig. nos. 5a-5d). Hide the line with several stitches between the rocailles and cut off the rest.

Step 6 Use a 4mm ring to connect the earring hook (fig. nos. 6a-6b).
