

There can never be enough patterns for fun Christmas decorations. Preciosa Ornela presents a simple tutorial for the simple creation of an additional decoration for blown Christmas baubles. They can be dressed in a fine seed bead net. Try the classic beadworking sewing technique improved by the use of the multifunctional PRECIOSA Twin™ two-hole seed bead. We wish you happy Christmas beadworking.

## Materials and Tools:

PRECIOSA Twin ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ ( $\mathbf{T}$ ) 32196 001; $2.5 \times 5 \mathrm{~mm} ; 78102$; 150x

PRECIOSA rocaille ( $\mathbf{R}$ ) 33119 001; 10/0; 78102; 1110x

a fine stringing needle, a 0.20 mm line, flat nosed pliers, scissors, an 8 cm diameter glass bauble

## Procedure:

The following description can be used to create a net, into which a blown bauble is placed and then enclosed. Create two identical parts of the net and join them together.

Step 1:
String 10x $\mathbf{T}$ with $3 \times \mathbf{R}$ between each one. Tie both ends of the line and create a circle (figure no. 1).

Step 2:


Pass the line through the second hole of the last $\mathbf{T}$. Then string $2 \times \mathbf{R}, 1 \times \mathbf{T}$ and $2 \times \mathbf{R}$ and continue in the same way to the end of the row and pass the line through the first two added $\mathbf{R}$ and one $\mathbf{T}$ once again according to the illustration and start the stringing of the next row (figure no. 2). Add a total of $40 \times \mathbf{R}$

Step 3:
Add one more $\mathbf{R}$ in each following row, but otherwise proceed in the same way as in the second row. Add 10x $\mathbf{R}$ between each of the individual $\mathbf{T}$ in the ninth row.

## Step 4:

Create two nets according to this tutorial. Place them onto a glass Christmas bauble from the adjacent sides and join both halves in the same way as in the ninth row.
