Material:

- 8 Arcos® par Puca® Paris
- 8 Samos® par Puca® Paris
- 16 Piros® par Puca®- Paris
 4 Colors
- Seed Beads 15/0 (SB15), 11/0 (SB11)
- 2 Jump Rings 4 mm ø
- 2 Cymbals (Pilos) or Jump rings
- 1 Pair Ear Wires
- 2 Tassels or Charms
- Fireline 0.12



1) Pick up 1 Arcos, 1 Piros, 1 SB15, 1 Piros through the Arcos HERE



2) Repeat step 1 with another color



3) Make 4 times in total and exit through the second hole of the Piros HERE



4) Pick up 2 SB15 through the central SB15



5) Pick up 2 SB15 through the second hole of the Piros



6) Pick up 1 SB15, 1
Samos and 1 SB15
through the Piros.
Repeat steps 4 to 6 all the way around



7) Here is the result Exit through the SB15, the Piros and the first SB15



8) Pick up 1 Piros, 1 SB15 and 1 Piros through the SB15, the Piros and the SB15 HERE



9) Pick up 3 SB15 through the second hole of the Samos



10) Pick up 3 SB15 through the Piros and the first SB15 HERE. Repeat steps 8 to 10 all the way around



11) Here is the result Exit through the central SB15 HERE



12) Pick up 2 SB15 through the second hole of the Piros



13) Pick up 1 SB11 through the two SB15 HERE



14) Pick up 3 SB15, 1 SB11 and 3 SB15 in the first two SB15 HERE



15) Pick up 1 SB11 through the second hole of the Piros. Repeat steps 12 to 15 all the way around



16) Here is the result Exit through the SB11 HERE



17) Pick up 1 SB15,1 Cymbal or jump ring1 SB15 and reinforce.End your thread



18) Make a second element and be careful to correctly place the colors in the opposite direction



19) Pick up the ear wire through the Cymbal



20) With a jump ring, place the tassel in the central SB11



21) Congratulations!
