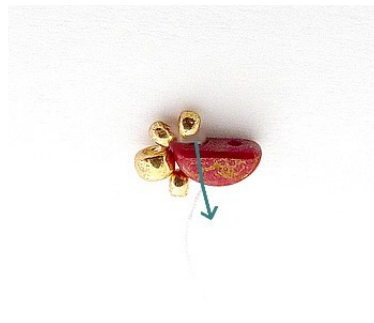
Material : For a 17cm bracelet

- 50 Kos® par Puca® color 1
- 4 Kos® par Puca® color 2
- 50 Kos® par Puca® color 3
- Seed beads 15/0 (R15), 11/0(R11), 8/0 (R8)
- 1 single row clasp
- 6 charms of your choice
- 15 cm of chain of your choice
- 4 rings Ø 4mm
- Fireline 0.12

You can wear Tri'O also as a necklace 😊
because your bracelet will measure 60cm in total 😊



1) Pick up 1 Kos, 1 R11, 1 R8, 2 R11, pass through the same hole again, repeat to strengthen



2) Exit like picture, through the same hole of Kos



3) Pick up 3R15 and exit through the second hole of Kos



4) Pick up 1 Kos, 3 R15 and exit through the second hole of Kos



5) Repeat step 4 on alternate sides for a total of 50 Kos



6) To the end, pick up 2 R11, 1 R8, 1 R11, pass through the same hole of Kos, repeat to strengthen



7) Exit like picture, through R8. We bead now the beaded chain



8) Pick up 3 R8, pass through first R8, exit like picture, through 3rd R8



9) Pick up 3 R15, 1 R8, 3 R15, pass through t the first R8 and the 3 R15



10) Exit through the following R8



11) Repeat steps 8 and 9 to bead 5 elements



12) Exit like picture, through R8



13) Pick up 1 R15, 1 Kos 2nd color, 3 R15, pass through 2nd hole of Kos, add 1 R15, exit through R8



14) Pass through all the beads to strengthen and exit like picture, through central R15



15) Pick up 1 R15, 1 Kos, 1 R11, 1 R8, 1 R11, pass through 2nd hole of Kos, add 1 R15 and exit through first R15



16) Pass through all the beads to strengthen and exit through central R8



17) Repeat steps 9 and 8 3 times and repeat steps 13 to 16



18) Repeat step 11



19) Repeat steps 4 and 5 with the 3rd color of Kos. You'll use a total of 50 Kos. Repeat steps 6 and 7, close your work



20) Place your chain with ring



21) Place your clasp with a ring



22) Place your charm's 😊



23) Congratulations! You have finished your Tri'O bracelet!
