



## “Marguerite” Beaded Bead



### Material (for one beaded bead)

Matubo Superduo (24 pcs)

11/0 Japanese seed beads (approx. 0.4 gram)

15/0 Japanese seed beads (approx. 0.4 gram)

4mm firepolished beads (4 pcs)

10mm round core bead (1 pc)

**Optional:** Stringing material of your choice (or headpins or eyepins), accent beads (bicones, rondelles), other jewelry findings as necessary.

**Beading needle and thread** (Nymo, Fireline...)


**Difficulty:** For beginners/intermediate




1) String one Superduo, one 15/0, one Superduo and one 11/0. Repeat four times total.




2) Slide all the beads to the end of the thread. Then tie a square knot to make a circle. This is what you should get. The thread is exiting between the Superduo and the 11/0.



3) Pass through the lower hole of the nearest Superduo ...




4) ... and then back through the upper hole of the same Superduo.



5) Add one 11/0 and pass through the upper hole of the next Superduo.




6) Add one 15/0, one Superduo, one 11/0, one Superduo, one 15/0, one Superduo, one 11/0, one Superduo, one 15/0, one Superduo and one 15/0 (so 6 Superduos, 4 15/0s and 3 11/0s in total).




7) Then pass through the upper hole of the Superduo from where you started in step 4, the next 11/0 and the upper hole of the next Superduo (from the opposite side from where the thread is exiting).




8) Pull snug. This is what you should get.




9) Pass through the next 15/0, lower hole of the next Superduo, 11/0, lower hole of the next Superduo ...




10) ... the next 15/0, lower hole of the next Superduo, 11/0 and the lower hole of the next Superduo (all from the new unit you just added).




11) Pass back through the upper hole of the same Superduo.



16) Just like in steps 5 and 12 add one 11/0 between the upper holes of the last "end" Superduos.



12) Repeat steps 5 - 11 ...




17) Add (15/0, Superduo, 11/0, Superduo, 15/0) and pass through the nearest "end" Superduo on the other end of the strip.




13 ... to add another unit ...




18) Add one 11/0 and pass through the upper hole of the next "end" Superduo.



14) ... and weave through beads ...



19) Add (15/0, Superduo, 11/0, Superduo, 15/0) and pass through the (Superduo (upper hole), 11/0, Superduo (upper hole) from where you started.




15) ... to get to the upper hole of the second "end" Superduo. Now you should have three units in the row.




20) Pull snug. If necessary weave through beads from steps 17, 18 and 19 one more time. You should get a cube-like structure, like this.




21) Put the core bead inside.




26) Repeat steps 24 and 25 ...



22) Weave through beads to get to the lower hole of the nearest "side" Superduo.




27) ... until you reach the end of the row.




23) Then pass back through the upper hole of the same Superduo.




28) Then weave through beads to get to the first 11/0 you added in this row.




24) In the gap in the corner (above the 15/0s) add another 15/0 and pass through the upper hole of the next Superduo.




29) Add two 15/0s and pass through the next 11/0 in the row.




25) In the gap above the 11/0 add one 11/0 and pass through the upper hole of the next Superduo.




30) Repeat step 29 ...



31) ... until you reach the end of the row.



36) Repeat step 35 ...




32) Then weave through all the four new pairs of 15/0s. Keep your tension as tight as possible.




37) ... until you reach the end of the row.




33) Then weave through beads to get to the upper hole of the nearest Superduo.



38) Weave through beads ...



34) Then pass back through the lower hole of the same Superduo - and also through the next 11/0, lower hole of the next Superduo and the next 15/0 - you should end up in the corner, as shown in the photo.




39) ... to get to the upper hole of one of the Superduos on the other side of the bead ...



35) Add one 11/0. Then pass through the next 15/0, the lower hole of the next Superduo, through the next 11/0, lower hole of the next Superduo and the next 15/0 - to get to the next corner.

40) ... and repeat steps 24 - 37 there.






41) This is what you should get.



42) Weave through beads to get to one of the free 11/0s in the middle - as shown in the photo.




43) Add one 15/0, one 4mm FP and one 15/0 and pass through the free 11/0 on the other side of the gap (as shown in the photo - from the same side the thread is exiting from).



44) Add one 15/0 and pass back through the 4mm FP

45) Add one 15/0 and pass through the same 11/0 from where you started in step 42/43 (from the opposite side from where the thread is exiting).




46) Pass through the nearest new 15/0.

47) Add two 15/0s and pass through the nearest free 11/0 on the side of the gap (as shown in the photo).



48) Add two 15/0s and pass through the nearest 15/0 on the other end of the 4mm FP (as shown in the photo).







49) Pass through the next 11/0 ...




54) Weave through beads ...



50) ... and through the next 15/0 ...



55) ... to get to the nearest free 11/0 on another side of the bead.



51) ... and just like in steps 47 and 48 ...



56) Repeat steps 43 - 55 until all four sides of the bead are decorated.



52) ... finish the circle around the 4mm FP



57) The bead is finished. Tie a few half-hitch knots and cut off all the remaining thread.



53) This is what you should get.
